Colour: Deep plum with a bright rim. Bouquet: The deep plum notes of ripe, primary shiraz fruit, opening to sweet, subdued florals and pepper berry. Palate: Broody, dark fruits and savoury flavour are encased in a rustic frame of gravelly, spicy tannin.

A favourable growing season, with good winter rains, a mild flowering and fruit set period and continued spring rainfall. Vines showed good balance of shoot vigour and moderate berry size. The ripening period that began late January was very cool, with some welcome rainfall in mid-February. The cold nights and mild sunny days in March slowed sugar accumulation, resulting in excellent fruit ripeness and intensity.

Colour Dense ruby and crimson. Bouquet This is a rich nose with distinct red-berry fruits and plums alongside sweet vanilla, nutmeg and baked short pastry. There's also dark chocolate ganache, dried thyme and tilled earth. Palate Close-knit fine tannins combine with fruit sweetness to give a super-plush mouthfeel. Emerging characters of raspberry jam, satsuma plum, star anise and milk chocolate flesh out the detail, with mocha, char and graphite to finish. There's depth and concentration in this classic McLaren Vale style, and the palate remains fresh and supple to the finish.

This is a full-bodied wine, yet it is the intricacy of the structure that draw me back to the glass. Long, beautiful and destined for excellent drinking across the midterm.

Colour: Deep impenetrable black Aroma: A tight drawn in bouquet on opening, slowly dark chocolate, deep cassis, liquorice, dried herbs, smoke, cedar, clove, mocha and condensed plum jelly emerge. Palate: "The dense fruits are coating over the palate, it throw layers of fruit at you which are easy to visualise along your palate. This is deep, slow moving with a great persistence, this is unashamedly Barossa Shiraz. Very few places the world over can make a wine with such depth, persistence, inner energy and light weight, the tannins are uber silky and seem to have an ability to continue to caress the mouth. Wow there is a lot to like here, the aspect of this wine that I like the most is that it feels that its holding something in reserve.

Dense midnight black in colour with a very deep dark red black hue. Intoxicating aromas of dark plum, liquorice, blackberry and mocha soar out of the glass with tremendous intensity. Vanillin cedar, earth, fennel and spicy pepper notes then chime in to add further complexity. Rich, refined and exceptionally long, the silky textured palate is awash with spicy dark plum, liquorice, blackberry and mocha flavours. Lying beneath the wealth of fruit are vanillin cedar, earth, faint leather and pepper characters. Cashmere like tannins are seamlessly integrated into the long powerful conclusion. This is world class Shiraz by any standard.

Grower Champagne

Champagne is the world's most famous sparkling wine. Hailing from the Champagne regions of France, its biggest names are among the biggest names in wine: Moet, Dom Perignon, Veuve Clicquot, Cristal. But there's another side to Champagne: a universe of small-scale producers preserving ancient family farming traditions and bottling wines you've never heard of.

These are the Grower Champagnes.

Grower Champagne is Champagne made by the farmer who grows the grapes that go into the bottle.

champagne presents a captivating bright yellow color with a subtle golden hue. Its aromatic profile is a delightful medley o fresh fruits, including apple, Mirabelle plum, and lemon, accompanied by nuanced notes of cut hay. The palate is a harmonious interplay of joyous brightness and lush vivacity, revealing a delightful fruit pastille and concluding with an enduring finish.

Jean Michel Cep Extra NV Champagne, France 210

Blending Meunier, Chardonnay, and Pinot Noir in equal parts, this wine undergoes sulphite-free fermentation and bottling. It showcases a golden color with straw reflections and a pure white foam. Aromatically mature, it exudes candied fruit notes like quince or candied orange, complemented by a pronounced hint of honey. The palate offers a delightful freshness and good length, featuring candied lemon notes and a subtle grilled touch that punctuates the finish.

2018 Elemart Robion Les Monets Extra Brut Millesime Champagne, France 240 € 240

An exquisite Pinot Meunier based Champagne from a small organic grower in the Ardre Valley. Les Monets is a small parcel of old vine Meunier - kept on the lees for three years, and bottles with ~2 grams of dosage. The Meunier makes this Champagne floral and spicy, with tons of fruit, but the low dosage keeps it very dry and racy. An ideal apertif-style champagne.

²2018 Elemart Robion 60/40 Extra Brut Champagne, France 260

The 60/40 champagne captivates with its luminous and fluid pale yellow color, enhanced by deep yellow highlights in the glass. Upon the initial scent, delicate fragrances of acacia, strawberry, and pineapple emerge, while aeration brings forth additional notes of fresh hazelnut, peeled hazelnut, white peach, fresh pear, and fresh butter. Transitioning to the palate, this champagne unfolds a pulpy fruity essence complemented by a lively interplay of lemony and orange acidity. The mid-palate experience is harmonized by a limestone minerality, accompanied by a subtle saltiness and hints of iodine aroma.

Robert Barbichon Blanc de Blanc NV (Biodynamic Grower) Côte Des Bar Champagne, France240

Champagne Robert Barbichon encapsulates four generations of dedication in the Côte des Bar, tending to 9 hectares of vines with unwavering commitment to biodynamic practices. Certified by Demeter in 2012 for biodynamics and holding Ecocert & AB certifications for organics, their champagne, matured for 36 months with 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Blanc, unfolds with floral notes of magnolia, citrus fruits, and pears. Fragrant and lively, it dances with appealing flavors of mint and lime, a medley of white fruits, fine perlage, and well-balanced acidity, embodying the brilliance of artisanal craftsmanship.

Robert Barbichon Brut Reserve 4 Cepages NV Côte Des Bar Champagne, France 260

Champagne Robert Barbichon, a culmination of four generations in the Côte des Bar, tends to 9 hectares of vines with unwavering dedication to biodynamic practices. Certified by Demeter in 2012 for biodynamics and holding Ecocert & AB certifications for organics, their 4 Cépages is a unique offering, blending all four varietals from their estate. Typically, Pinot Noir dominant, aged for 30 months on lees, it enchants with an elegant nose of peaches and almonds, delivering a fresh, linear profile with impeccable balance.

▶ Robert Barbichon Brut Blanc de Noir NV Côte Des Bar Champagne, France

In the glass, the Blanc de Noirs from Robet Barbichon shows a fine bouquet of ripe fruits such as pear and grapefruit. On the palate nice and soft and round. Barbichon champagnes are simply something special. Mineral and yet very elegant, you will be enchanted by each bottle again and again and encouraged to drink another.

Champagne

Champagne's flavor, aroma, and experience on the palate is affected by the three grapes used in making it: <u>Chardonnay</u>, <u>Pinot Noir</u>, and <u>Pinot Meunier</u>. Chardonnay is generally the main grape used in blending Champagne (and nearly all Champagne is a blend), but some versions use only the black grapes.

160 Pommery Brut Apanage NV Champagne, France The fine buttery almost pastry-based aromas are quickly joined by a bouquet of forest flowers and notes of candied citrus and blood orange. Moët & Chandon Impérial NV Champagne, France 170 A sparkling bouquet: The vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit, The freshness of mineral nuances and white flowers, The elegance of blond notes (brioche, cereal, fresh nuts) Champagne Louis Roederer Collection NV Reims, France 190 The bouquet is open and rich yet also wonderfully fresh. It offers an explosion of ripe, delicate fruit with intense notes of yellow fruit (mirabelle plum) from the Pinot noir complemented by sweet citrus fruits (lemon meringue pie) and delicate notes of white flowers (jasmine) from the Chardonnay. The nose opens up to reveal autolytic characters and evolves towards smoky, roasted notes and freshly baked pastries. Champagne Taittinger Presitge NV Champagne, France 145 The brilliant body is golden yellow in colour. The bubbles are fine, while the foam is discreet yet lingering. The nose, very open and expressive, delivers aromas of fruit and brioche. it also gives off the fragrance of peach, white flowers (hawthorn, acacia) and vanilla pod. Champagne Taittinger Prestige Rosé NV Champagne, France 195 Aromas of red fruits, freshly crushed wild raspberry, cherry, blackcurrant. The palate can be summed up in four words: lively, fruity, fresh and elegant, as only a rosé blend can be. 2014 Champagne Taittinger Brut Millésimé Champagne, France 290 The nose of this 2014 vintage expresses beautiful complexity. There are floral aromas of hawthorn and pleasant notes of pear, kumquat, verbena, gingerbread and white flowers, underpinned by a subtle minty note. On the palate, it releases superb energy; a fresh and dynamic attack with floral tones such as honeysuckle combined with delightful notes of peach and citrus fruits. The finish is subtle with lovely longlasting aromas on top of pleasingly bitter orange peel. 2014 Champagne Louis Roederer Cristal Brut Reims, France 820 Fruity palate with a silky texture, complemented by soft bubbles that are perfectly integrated and deliciously elegant. The purity and perfection of the ripe yellow fruit melt into the intense chalky freshness, typical of Cristal, that is both powdery and saline. Dense, juicy, concentrated and long on the mid-palate, thanks to the spicy and sappy structure resulting from partial ageing in large oak vats (foudres). Ruinart Blanc de Blancs Brut NV Reims, France 280 The first nose reveals intense aromas of fresh fruit: ripe lemon, juicy pear, or freshly picked peach. The secondary aromas are more floral with hints of white flowers, accompanied by a spicy touch combining ginger and pink peppercorns. Balancing tension with roundness, the enveloping structure is highlighted by fresh aromas of ripe citrus and tropical fruit. With a long and delicate finale. Ruinart Rose NV Reims, France 280 First impressions reveal intense aromas of tropical fruit such as pomegranate, lychee and guava, complemented by floral essences of damask rose and freshly picked red berries. Secondary aromas include hints of warm spices such as tonka bean and nutmeg. The elegant finish provides notes of peppermint and pink grapefruit.

2013 Dom Perignon Eparnay Champagne

Dom Perignon is the most recognisable Champagne worldwide.

Rich, complex concentrated stone fruits, fresh croissants & a lingering oyster shell finish.

Each vintage is a creation, singular and unique, that expresses both the character of the year, & the character of Dom Perignon.

Sparkling wine

Sparkling wine might just be the most technical of all wines in the world–even if it is so easy to drink! The reason most sparkling wine is so complex is because of the need for two fermentations; one to make wine and the other to make bubbles. Since sparkling wines were first introduced (starting in the mid 1500's), several processes have been developed and each result in a unique sub-style of sparkling wine.

Pinot Gris & Grigio

You probably already knew that Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio are the same wine.

What's surprising is that this grayish-purple grape is also a mutation of Pinot Noir.

Pinot Gris is famous for its refreshing citrus flavor and zesty acidity.

The primary fruit flavors in Pinot Grigio are lime, lemon, pear, white nectarine and apple. Depending on where the grapes are grown, Pinot Grigio can take on faint honeyed notes, floral aromas like honeysuckle, and a saline-like minerality.

Is there a difference between Pinot Grigio and Pinot Gris? No, not technically speaking. They are the same.

Tasting Riesling starts with intense aromas that rise from the glass (even when the wine is ice cold). This aromatic wine offers primary fruit aromas of orchard fruits like nectarine, apricot, honey-crisp apple, and pear. Besides fruit, you'll often smell things like honeycomb, jasmine, or lime peel. Rose wine

Pink wine happily spans the colorspace between red and white wine, in a way, rosé is more like a state of mind.

Rosé happens when the skins of red grapes touch wine for only a short time. Where some red wines ferment for weeks at a time on red grape skins, rosé wines are stained red for just a few hours. The winemaker has complete control over the color of the wine, and removes the red grape skins (the source of the red pigment) when the wine reaches the perfect color.

As you can imagine, nearly any red wine grape (from Cabernet Sauvignon to Syrah) can be used to make rosé wine,

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir is the name of a grape, and the single-varietal wine produced from that grape. The name comes from the French words for "pine" and "black," a reference to the pine-cone shape of its clusters on the vine and the color of the grapes.

At first glance, most Pinot Noir wines are pale to medium in color due to their thin skins. Pinot Noir has a unique profile dominated by aroma compounds known as esters. These give it a complex array of flavors, from ripe cherry and raspberry to intriguing undertones of forest floor, tea leaves, and sometimes even clove.

Gamay & Grenache

The rum's darker color and bolder flavor come from the wooden or charred oak barrels used in the aging process. During this aging process, producers also add ingredients to add flavors and colors. Commonly, molasses, burnt sugar, caramel, and spices, are added to naturally enhance the flavor of dark rum. The longer the rum is aged, the darker it becomes and the bolder the flavor.

Brandy generally refers to a distilled spirit made from fermented fruit juice. It can be produced using grapes or other types of fruit, such as apples. Calvados, pisco, armagnac, and applejack are all types of brandy. Unlike cognac, brandy can be made anywhere in the world.

While cognac is a type of brandy, to earn the designation, the spirit must meet certain specific criteria. Named for the region where it's produced (just like champagne) cognac must be made in the state of Charente in the Cognac region of France, and be made from white grapes from one of six different terroirs; the <u>Ugni Blanc grape variety</u> is its primary ingredient, and grapes from "<u>Grande Champagne</u>" terroir are the most coveted.
