Champagne

Champagne's flavor, aroma, and experience on the palate is affected by the three grapes used in making it: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Chardonnay is generally the main grape used in blending Champagne (and nearly all Champagne is a blend), but some versions use only the black grapes.

The reason most sparkling wine is so complex is because of the need for two fermentations; one to make wine and the other to make bubbles. Since sparkling wines were first introduced (starting in the mid 1500's), several processes have been developed and each result in a unique sub-style of sparkling wine.

Pinot Gris & Grigio

You probably already knew that Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio are the same wine.

What's surprising is that this grayish-purple grape is also a mutation of Pinot Noir.

Pinot Gris is famous for its refreshing citrus flavor and zesty acidity.

The primary fruit flavors in Pinot Grigio are lime, lemon, pear, white nectarine and apple. Depending on where the grapes are grown, Pinot Grigio can take on faint honeyed notes, floral aromas like honeysuckle, and a saline-like minerality.

Is there a difference between Pinot Grigio and Pinot Gris? No, not technically speaking. They are the same.

Riesling

Tasting Riesling starts with intense aromas that rise from the glass (even when the wine is ice cold). This aromatic wine offers primary fruit aromas of orchard fruits like nectarine, apricot, honey-crisp apple, and pear. Besides fruit, you'll often smell things like honeycomb, jasmine, or lime peel. On the palate, Riesling has high acidity, similar to the levels in lemonade.

Rose wine

Pink wine happily spans the colorspace between red and white wine, in a way, rosé is more like a state of mind.

Rosé happens when the skins of red grapes touch wine for only a short time. Where some red wines ferment for weeks at a time on red grape skins, rosé wines are stained red for just a few hours.

The winemaker has complete control over the color of the wine, and removes the red grape skins (the source of the red pigment) when the wine reaches the perfect color.

As you can imagine, nearly any red wine grape (from Cabernet Sauvignon to Syrah) can be used to make rosé wine,

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir is the name of a grape, and the single-varietal wine produced from that grape. The name comes from the French words for "pine" and "black," a reference to the pine-cone shape of its clusters on the vine and the color of the grapes.

At first glance, most Pinot Noir wines are pale to medium in color due to their thin skins. Pinot Noir has a unique profile dominated by aroma compounds known as esters. These give it a complex array of flavors, from ripe cherry and raspberry to intriguing undertones of forest floor, tea leaves, and sometimes even clove.

Burgundy or Bourgogne

What to expect: When tasting Burgundian Pinot Noir, you may note its more earthy and floral style. This is part of Burgundy's terroir.

The world's most coveted Pinot Noir vines grow on a narrow, east-facing slope just South of Dijon. Burgundy is a very old wine region and was first tended by Cistercian monks in the Middle Ages.

Did you know? Bourgogne is the only wine region in France whose name is translated into different languages: "Burgundy" in English, "Burgund" in German, "Borgogna" in Italian, to name but a few.

Shiraz & Syrah


Are Syrah and Shiraz the same grape?

In a word - yes.

Syrah and Shiraz are actually just two different names for the same grape variety.

In Australia, this red grape variety is called Shiraz, and that's the term we Aussies are most familiar with.

Syrah is originally a French word, but also in the rest of the world, this variety is called Syrah.

Tempranillo

Spanish Tempranillo delivers contrasting flavors of leather and cherries. The finer the wine, the more balance there is between earth and fruit. The finish is typically smooth and lingers with the taste of tannin on both sides of your mouth. Tempranillo wines from New World regions, including Argentina, Mexico, and the United States, generally offer more fruit flavors like cherry and tomato-sauce, followed by chunky tannins and less earthy notes.

Cabernet Sauvignon & Blends

The world's most popular red wine grape is a natural cross between Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon Blanc from Bordeaux, France. Cabernet Sauvignon is loved for its high concentration and age worthiness.

Cabernet Sauvignon is one of the more complex and layered wines out there. It has higher tannins and a savory character often described as black pepper and tobacco.

Sangiovese

It might surprise you to know that Sangiovese is actually quite scarce outside of Italy. In terms of world plantings, Sangiovese is less abundant than even little-known Mourvedre.

The Sangiovese grape is a bit of a chameleon; easily altering its genetics to fit the environment. There are many different mutations of the variety all over Italy, which results in very different tasting wines. From the delicate floral strawberry aromas of Montefalco Rosso to the intensely dark and tannic wines of Brunello di Montalcino, Sangiovese wine has something for everyone.
